
Universal Monotheistic Gnosticism

The Religion that came from Heaven



Urianism is a noun derived from the Hebrew word "Urian", meaning "From Heaven". In a religious context, it means "The religion that came from Heaven". Urian, the word for an adherent of Urianism, means "From Heavenist". This is, in practice, the ideal of striving to be heavenly, transcendent and overcoming what Urians believe to be the "trap of reincarnation".




The Dur.An.Ki. (Duranki) is our symbol (figure-eight-cross or double ankh) and is derived from a Sumerian term meaning, "bond between heaven and earth." It is every Urian's goal to become an immortal being — a bond between heaven and earth (above and below).

The Ahyeh teaches that there is a mediator spirit, the Immanuel, Cosmic Inter-Universal Christ (The Lamb described in Revelation 5), who manifests as prophets and messengers throughout history. Jesus being the greatest manifestation of the mediator spirit. This mediator is the personification and personal face(s) of God the One, who leads us to the feet of the One God.

We are not against any monotheistic religion, but are against cruelty, torture, terrorism, racism (even toward whites), and sexism toward women or men (we are anti-chauvinism and anti-feminism and for a balance between the two).

We are against the Fascist Liberal and Mammonists (Capitalist) Agendas, as well as any movement that advocates for torture, rape, mass murder or mutilation, especially in regards to children.



Those members who are by their true nature soft, kind, gentle, patient, and charitable, desiring peace and good will, slow to anger and quick to forgive – such ones should wear the white robes of the White Pillar Path.

They that are, in the truth of themselves, ingoing, thoughtful, intellectual, contemplative, given to private devotion, or who see moderation and balance as most important, should don the gray robes of the Middle Pillar Path.

Those who are by nature passionate, fiery, stern, ascetic, and least tolerant of the world and of evil, should wear the black robes of the Black Pillar Path.
